Subject aim Familiarise students with the terminology of the disciplines related to sport and their training for communication in the field of those disciplines. Learning the key grammar units necessary in everyday speech and acquiring all the necessary skills for active use of English. All the mentioned should contribute to the purposeful use of English in the sense of an aware and self-confident articulation of thoughts in a foreign language.			
Subject outcome Students who successfully realise all the subject tasks should know the key grammar and lexical units necessary in everyday speech, know the basic term determinants of sport and related disciplines, their formation and standardisation, and the contrastive aspect of English and Serbia in sport terminology, know the basic rules of correspondence in English, be skilled to read professional texts with understanding, be trained to communicate in written and oral communication, be trained to make reports on a sport event, and use the reference literature.			
Subject content <i>Theory</i> Introductory notes related to literature, subject, manner of teaching and taking exams, diagnostic tests, “Olympic Games”, nouns (plural, gender, formation), “Sports: Pros and Cons”, adjectives (formation and comparison), “The Human Body”, “The S Factors”, phrasal verbs, “Sources of Energy”, derivation, “Keeping Fit”, forming negative adjectives, “Drugs in Sport”, translation of English terms into Serbian “Going to the Doctors”, Imperative, “Aesthetics in Sports”, phrasal verbs with particles “up” and “off”, “The Sociology of Sport”, derivation of nouns, adjectives, and adverbs, newspaper text editing and analysis of lexical relations, presentation and analysis of seminar papers, playing a film from the field of sport and practicing listening comprehension, revision for the written exam.
