Prerequisites: Relevant methodic exams passed. Note: For students already working in some of the preschool institutions, practice is NOT mandatory.		
Course Aims: Training students for independent performance of the educational process. Application of acquired theoretical knowledge from didactic-methodical group of subjects in a group of children of preschool age. Students are performing professional tasks of educators (2 weeks of practice during the summer semester). Participate in all types of activities.		
Learning Outcomes: Ability to work independently with children of preschool age: planning, preparing, organizing, realization, analysis and self-evaluation of activities of the students and the children. Creative and innovative solutions in work. Monitoring the possibilities of professional development; professional literature.		
Syllabus: The student gets all the required information and instructions on, chooses a preschool institution and a teacher-mentor. The two-weeks practice takes place in the facilities of the Preschool Institutions in Subotica, during the summer semester. The entire practice is an independent educational work of the student. The student leads activities and extracurricular activities. The emphasis is on the game, on the socialization of children and on educational processes. The acquired competencies of the student (communication, creativity, innovation) should be expressed. The student takes care of children with special needs. The teachers- mentors visit the students and evaluate their work. The student is obliged to write a Workbook during the period of the practice. After the completed practice, the students Workbook is submitted to the coordinator of the teaching practice at the Faculty.

Teaching Methods: The practice is done under the mentorship of a teacher with previously specified aims and expected outcomes of the practice. Consultations, analysis, discussion, evaluation. The student holds classes for two weeks.
