Prerequisites: Exams in German language I and II passed.
Course Aims: Students master B2 level in German and improve general language competence within four language skills (reading and listening, writing and speaking), in order to understand professional texts. Developing professional communication skills.
Learning Outcomes: B2 in German, deepened and enhanced general language competencies within four language skills. Students have developed communication skills, they understand and use professional terminology.
Syllabus: <i>Theory</i> During the course, all four linguistic skills are developed (reading of text, listening the text, speaking and writing), but with a special emphasis on vocabulary connected to pedagogy. Knowledge on basic grammatical structures and laws (phonetics, morphology, verbal system) is systematized, deepened and actively applied. <i>Practice</i> The aim is to encourage students to communicate among each other. Students enrich their vocabulary with lexical units and idioms from their profession and use them in communication.
