The link between natural and cultural heritage at the destination. Methods for identifying market segments that visit this type of destination and their needs when visiting natural destinations. Management of natural resources and development of tourism in protected natural resources. Getting to know the most famous destinations of this type in the world and their management system. Global trends, characteristics and perspectives of tourism based on natural resources. Thematic routes with natural resources as the main attraction. <i>Practical instruction</i> Preparation of seminar papers. Analysis of different market segments and their needs when visiting natural tourism destinations. Analysis of natural tourism destinations in the world and in our country and their management through specific examples (case studies). Analysis of legal acts related to the relationship between nature and tourism, as well as analysis of the role and ways of using natural resources in strategic documents
