#### **Course Aims:**

The goal is to students acquire knowledge about the problems of plant and/or livestock organic production during the production process.

## **Learning Outcomes:**

Acquiring knowledge about how theoretical knowledge is transferred and applied in practice, ie. how the acquired theoretical knowledge is applied and adapted to the given growing conditions.

### **Syllabus:**

Farm selection by students. Introduction to all operations that are applied in production on the selected farm. Depending on the type of production, students would gain information about the processes of plant or livestock organic production during the summer or early autumn.

After the production practice, students are required to submit the diary of practice (in the form that will be distributed to them) and to defend their work through a presentation, with reference to the basic activities of the farm, applied operations and given suggestions and opinions on certain changes.
