<b>Learning Outcomes:</b> Acquisition of knowledge in the field of tropical medicine which are not familiar with veterinary students in the framework of the mandatory subject of Infectious Diseases, because they rarely register in Serbia except as imported cases.			
<b>Syllabus:</b> <i>Theory</i> Tropical diseases-introduction, distribution, significance, zoonotic aspects, leishmaniasis, triposomiasis, filariasis, rabies, malaria, haemorrhagic fevers, arboviruses  <i>Practice</i> Microscopic diagnosis of most important tropical diseases in the blood smears from the WHO collection.
