<b>Syllabus:</b> <i>Theory</i> Interactive activities in foreign language teaching; participation / autonomy. Strategies and techniques of work in interactive teaching of French. Strategies and techniques of problem and active learning: direct and indirect, cognitive, metacognitive and socio-affective. Characteristics of communicative activities; activities of "lower" and "higher" levels; activity functions. External and internal motivation. Forming a group. Group work and work in pair. Development of various activities for the language skills development: listening, oral expression, reading, writing; language skills. Creating interactive activities: use of authentic documents, development of teaching materials, different types of tasks. The role of teachers; attitude towards mistakes. Free activities. Evaluation. <i>Practice</i> Structure and techniques analysis of the teaching material for interactive, problem and active teaching. Preparation of two teaching units (grammar /reading/oral expression/discussion). Preparation of materials for the Fair of science and education.
