Knowledge of the structure of a new harmonic expression and recognition of the most important processes in creating a contemporary piece of music. Capability to apply the acquired knowledge in practice.			
Syllabus: Extended tonality, indefinite mode, two-chord structures, mixed parallelism of chords, mediants, triads at a distance of a tritone structure, multi-chord notes, free dissonance, bichord, polychord, cumulus, secundal, quartal, incidental chords, clusters.
