Practice

Mixing actor-centred techniques of "psychological realism" with "breaking the fourth wall", narration, coming out of a character, freeze frames/tableaux. Assigning a contra-role to student's personality. Collaboration with other professors at the Academy (e.g. dramaturgy, stage movement, acrobatics, dance, stage speech), who will participate in the project, i.e. final performance.
